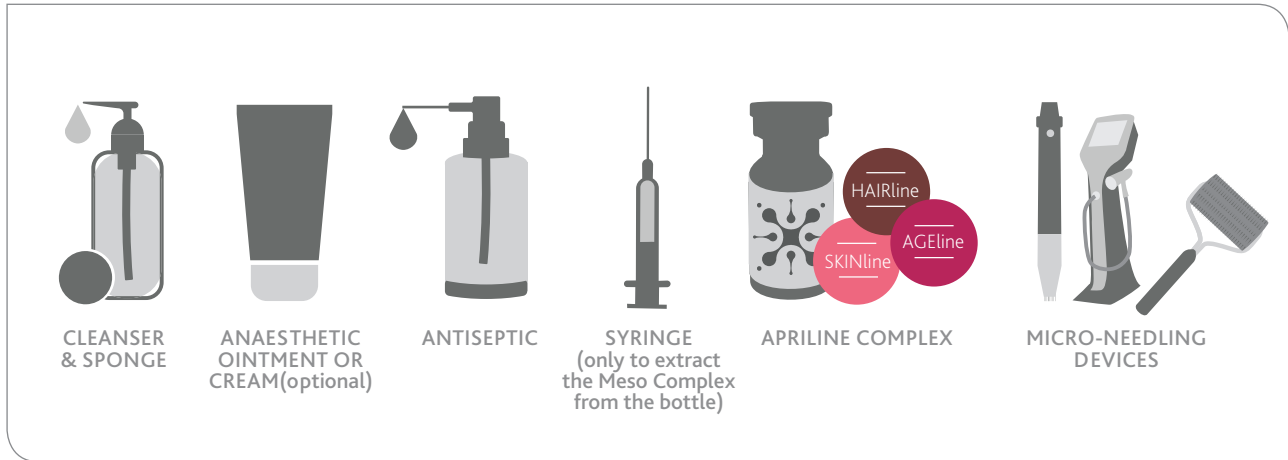


PROTOCOLS: APRILINE FOR MICRO-NEEDLING

WHAT DO I NEED TO PERFORM THIS PROTOCOL?



STEP 1: CLEAN

Cleanse the skin with a cleanser of your choice based on the clients' skin type and condition.

STEP 2: ELIMINATE DISCOMFORT (NUMBING)

- Apply and spread anaesthetic ointment or cream of your choice to the treatment region. It is important to read the user's manual of the anaesthetic cream before its application.
- Leave the anaesthetic cream on the skin surface for about 15-30 minutes before removing it.
- For better results, optionally occlude with plastic wrap for the duration of the waiting period.
- Remove all residue of the anaesthetic product.
- Clean the skin with an antiseptic.

PROTOCOLS: APRILINE FOR MICRO-NEEDLING

STEP 3: APPLY ACTIVE INGREDIENTS – APRILINE COMPLEX

a) Choose Apriline complex according to the treatment area and expected results.



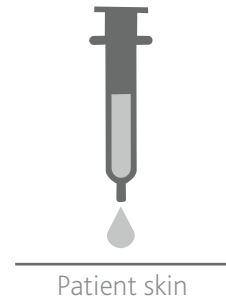
b) Pull approximately 2ml of Apriline complex out of a sterile bottle with any type of syringe available.



c) Remove the needle and dispose of in a sharp container.



d) Apply Apriline complex with a syringe of your choice (using the tip, no needling) in each treatment area before micro-needling, section by section.



STEP 4: STIMULATE DEEPER PENETRATION THANKS TO MICRONEEDLING

- Perform micro-needling following manufacturer training.
- In case of the derma-roller we recommend to do at least 6 passages in multiple directions for each treatment area.
- Micro-channels created by the microneedling device allow active ingredients to penetrate deeper into the skin and to boost the treatment effects.
- At all times observe the effect on the skin and adjust needle depth accordingly.
- Disinfect the skin with an antiseptic solution.
